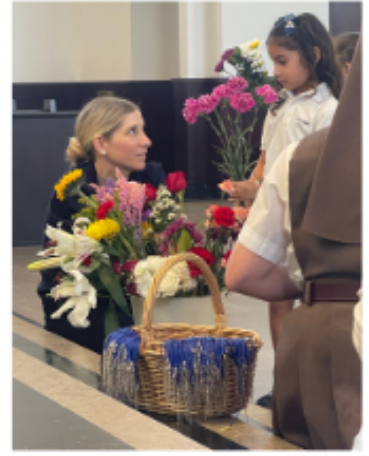
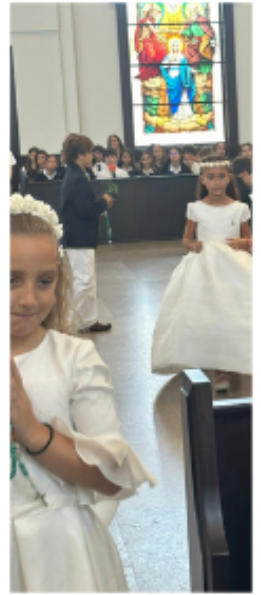
May Crowning

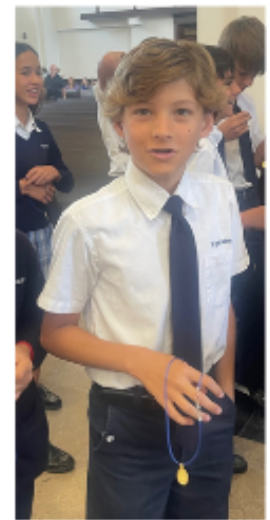
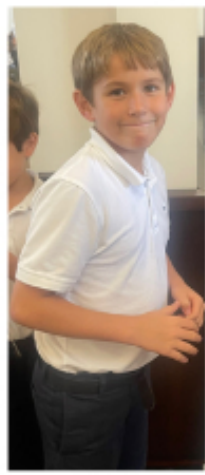
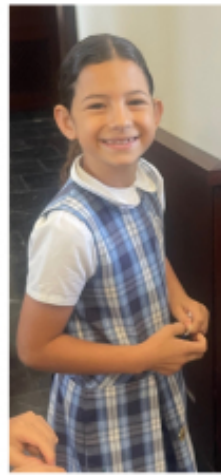

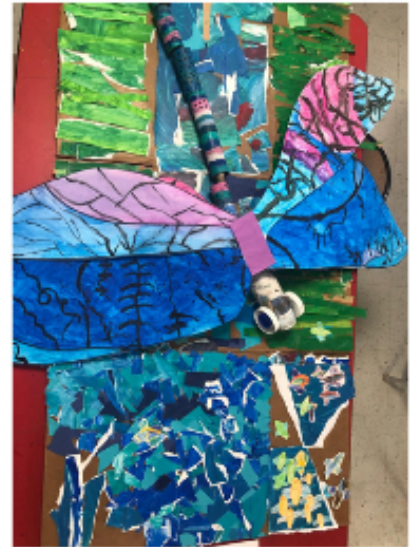
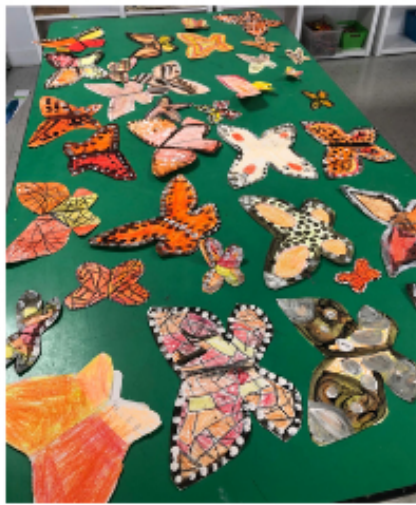
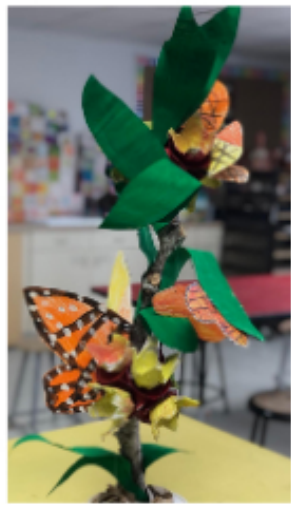
Key Biscayne Citizen Scientist Project

Native Animals & Their Habitats

The Citizen Scientist Project of the Key Biscayne Community Foundation and the Village of Key Biscayne sponsor the Key Challenge which is an island-wide initiative directed at increasing students' appreciation and knowledge of the island's natural resources. The Challenge incorporates 4 disciplines - art, writing, informatics, and science. This Year's Key Challenge invited participants to create projects that were centered around native animals and their habitats. St. Agnes students from various grades spent time learning about these native animals, their habitats, the threats they face, and how to protect them. They each submitted incredible creations using recycled materials. Our St. Agnes winners from Ms. Sonia Sanchez's classes were from her:

5th Grade MATH



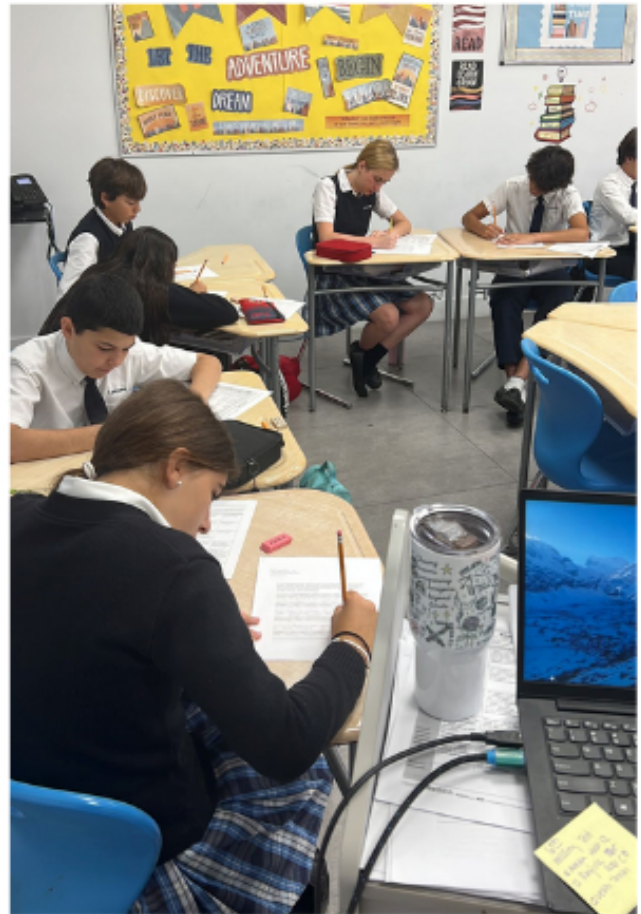

It's Time To Apply! Step Up For Students 2024 - 2025

Renewal Scholarship Students

Families with children that were already enrolled in the Step Up For Students program, may now RENEW their student's Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities, Florida Tax Credit Scholarship, or Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options for the 2024-2025 school year. As a reminder, current families who would like to renew their student's scholarship must complete the Step Up For Students application annually. For instructions on how to renew your student's scholarship, check your email or login to your Step Up For Students portal.

New Scholarship Applicants

Families may now apply for a 2024-25 scholarship for the following programs:

- Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC)*
- Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO)*
- Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA)

*With recently passed legislation, if signed by the Governor, the Hope Scholarship will merge with the FTC and FES-EO programs. Families who are benefiting from the Hope Scholarship for the 2023-24 school year will apply through the FTC/FES-EO programs to renew their student's scholarship for the 2024-25 school year.
